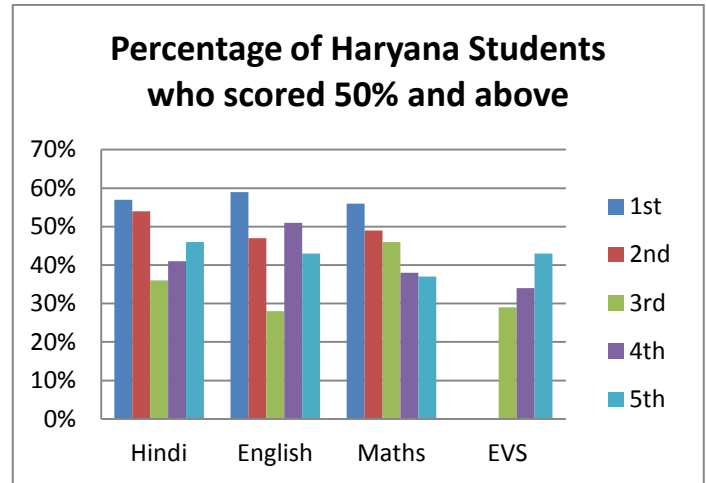
Till the finalization of report, 98% of data has been entered.

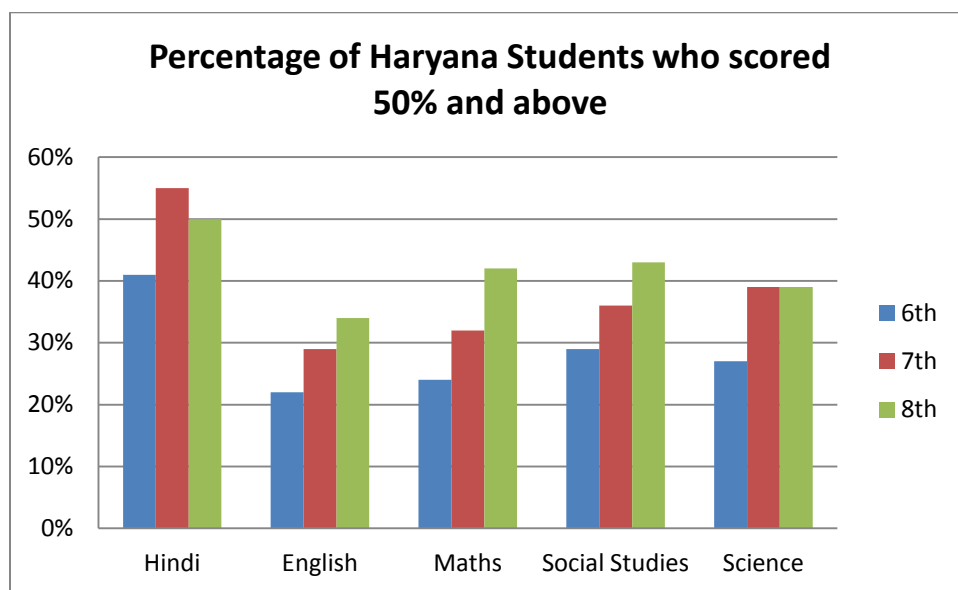
In Hindi, performance of students scoring above 50% marks has drastically decreased from class 1st to 3rd; it has marginally improved in class 4th and 5th.

In English, performance of students scoring above 50% marks has decreased from class 1st to class 3rd, then it increased in class 4th, again it has decreased in class 5th.

In Mathematics, performance of students has continuously decreased from class 1st to 5th.

In EVS, performance of students increased in class 4th as compare to class 3rd and further increased in 5th class.

Performance of students scoring above 50% marks has increased from class 6th to 8th in English, Maths and Social Studies. In Hindi, performance of students has decreased from class 7th to 8th. In Science, it remains constant from class 7th to 8th. However, there is a sharp decline in performance level of students from class 5th to 6th in Hindi, English and Mathematics.

Performance of students in Hindi is higher in comparison to English, Mathematics, Social studies and Science in all the classes.

Performance of students across classes and districts, Gurgaon and Sonapat are in tie for 1st position, whereas, Mahendergarh and Rewari are on 2nd and 3rd position respectively. Bottom performing Districts are again the same, Mewat, Palwal & Yamuna Nagar. When we compare the performance of students across months, Improvement is observed in 11 districts and declined is observed in 5 districts. In rest of the districts, there is no change in the performance level of students. Performance of top performing districts Jhajjar, Mahendergarh and Rewari, has declined, however in Gurgaon and Sonipat, it has increased. In bottom performing districts, improvement has been noticed.

Across Classes and subjects, when we compare results of August, 2015 with previous months, it is observed that students of class-1st need special attention as in all three subjects. Decline in performance is observed in all subjects i.e. Hindi (-11%), English (-09%) & Mathematics (-12%).

In Class 2nd also, declined is observed in all subjects i.e. in hindi (1%), in English (-19%) and in Mathematics (-12%), decline is found.

In class 3rd, decline is observed in English by 7% and in EVS 2%.

In class 4th, improvement in result is noticed in English by 13% and in Math by 2% but EVS performance decreased by 4%.

In 5th Class, English language has 5% improvement in performance but Mathematics needs improvement because result has declined by 8%.

In 6th to 8th classes, improvement has been noticed in results to some extent in the month of August, 2015.

In this month, 6th Class need more attention in Mathematics, Social Studies and Science as they have reflected decline of 9%, 5% and 7% respectively.

In 7th class, Hindi language has shown remarkable improvement in learning outcome of students by 15%, whereas in Social Studies, decline is evident of 5%.

In 8th class, English (5%), Hindi (3%) and Mathematics (11%) have shown improvement, whereas in Social Studies and Science, decline is observed in comparison with previous months.
