

## January MAT Report 2018

In January MAT 2018, 96 % of schools have entered data. Across districts, it is more than state average in 9 districts named Ambala, Bhiwani, Faridabad, Fatehabad, Gurugram, Hisar, Jhajar, Jind, Kaithal, Karnal, Mahendergarh, Panipat, Rewari, Rohtak, Sirsa and Sonipat. In rest of the districts, it is less than the state average (Table 1).

Attendance of students in January MAT 2018 is 94% at state level. Across districts, attendance is more than state average in 14 districts namely, Ambala, Bhiwani, Faridabad, Fatehabad, Gurugram, Hisar, Jhajjar, Jind, Kaithal, Karnal, Mahendergarh, Mewat, Panchkula and Panipat. It is less than state average in 5 districts named Rewari, Rohtak, Sirsa, Sonipat and Yamuna Nagar. It is at par the state average in 2 districts named Kurukshetra and Palwal (Table 2).

In January MAT 2018, Mahendergarh and Rewari districts are in tie for first position. Gurguram and Jhajjar districts are in tie for second position. Sonipat is at third position. However Mewat, Yamuna Nagar, Palwal and Fatehabad are the bottom performing districts (Table 3).

In January MAT 2018, across primary classes, **in Hindi**, performance of students is good in all classes i.e. more than 50% students are scoring above 50% marks, however, it has decreased in class 3<sup>rd</sup>, but again improved in class 4<sup>th</sup> and class 5<sup>th</sup>. **In English**, performance of students has decreased tremendously in class 3<sup>rd</sup> and further decreased in class 4<sup>th</sup> and reached less than 50% i.e. only 47% students are scoring more than 50% marks. Performance of students crossed the benchmark of 50% in class 5<sup>th</sup>. **In Mathematics**, performance of students is good in all classes i.e. more than 50% students are scoring above 50% marks; however, in class 4<sup>th</sup>, it has just crossed the minimum decided performance line. **In EVS**, performance of students is good as more than 50% students are achieving more than 50% marks in all three classes (Table 4).

Across upper primary classes, in January MAT 2018, **in Hindi**, performance of students is good in all three classes 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>; however, it is improved from class 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>. In English also, students are performing poorly in class 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> and in class 7<sup>th</sup>, it has just crossed the minimum decided performance line. **In Mathematics**, performance of students is poor in all three classes. **In Social Studies**, performance of students is poor in all three classes; however in class 6<sup>th</sup>, it is at 52% i.e. only 52% students are scoring more than 50% marks. In Science, students are performing well in all three classes (Table 5).

Across Districts, **in Hindi**, students are performing well in all districts in class 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>. In class 3<sup>rd</sup>, performance of students is good in all the districts except Mewat and Palwal, however, in Fatehabad, it is at 50% i.e. 50% students are scoring more than 50% marks. In Class 4<sup>th</sup> performance of students is good in all the districts except Palwal, however in Mewat 50% students are scoring more than 50% marks (Table 6).

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**In English**, class 1<sup>st</sup> students are performing well in all the districts except Mewat, however in Palwal, it is at 50% bench mark. In class 2<sup>nd</sup>, students are performing well in all the districts except Palwal, however in Mewat, it is at 50% bench mark. In class 3<sup>rd</sup>, students are performing well in most of the districts except Fatehabad, Kaithal, Kurukshetra, Mewat and Palwal and Yamuna Nagar. In Class 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>, students' performance is poor in most of the districts (Table 7).

**In Mathematics** also, class 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, students are performing well in all districts. In class 3<sup>rd</sup>, performance of students is well in all districts except Palwal. In class 4<sup>th</sup>, performance of students is good in most of the districts except Fatehabad, Kaithal, Kurukshetra, Mewat, Palwal and Yamuna Nagar, however, in Jind and Karnal, it just at bench mark line of 50%. In class 5<sup>th</sup>, performance of students is good in all the districts except Fatehabad, Mewat, Palwal and Yamuna Nagar. In class 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>, students are performing poorly in all the districts and in class 8<sup>th</sup>, students are performing poorly in most of the districts except Gurugram, Jhajjar, Mahendergarh, Rewari and Sonipat, in Rohtak and Faridabad have just reached to the bench mark of 50% (Table 8).

In EVS, class 5<sup>th</sup> students are performing well in all the districts except Palwal . However, Mewat has reached the bench mark of 50%. In class 4<sup>th</sup>, students are performing well in all the districts except Mewat. However, Palwal has reached the bench mark of 50%. In Class 3<sup>rd</sup>, students' are performing well in most of the districts except Mewat, Palwal and Yamuna Nagar. Fatehabad has reached the bench mark of 50% (Table 9).

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**In Social Studies**, across districts, students of class 6<sup>th</sup> are performing well in most of the districts except Fatehabad, Jind, Kaithal , Karnal, Mewat, Palwal, Sirsa and Yamuna Nagar. In class 8<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> also, students are performing poorly in most of the districts except some districts. They need much improvement (Table 10).

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**In Science**, performance of class 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> students' is good except Fatehabad, Jind, Kaithal, Mewat and Yamuna Nagar. In class 6<sup>th</sup>, performance of students is good in most of the districts except Ambala, Fatehabad, Jind, Kaithal, Mewat, Palwal and Yamun Nagar (Table 11).

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## Conclusion

In January MAT 2018, 96 % of schools have entered data. Attendance of students in January MAT 2018 is 94% at state level. In January MAT 2018, Mahendergarh and Rewari districts are in tie for first position. Gurguram and Jhajjar districts are in tie for second position. Sonipat is at third position. However Mewat, Yamuna Nagar, Palwal and Fatehabad are the bottom performing districts.

Across primary classes, **in Hindi, performance** of students is good in all classes i.e. more than 50% students are scoring above 50% marks, however, it has decreased in class 3<sup>rd</sup>, but again improved in class 4<sup>th</sup> and class 5<sup>th</sup>. **In English**, performance of students has decreased tremendously in class 3<sup>rd</sup> and further decreased in class 4<sup>th</sup> and reached less than 50% i.e. only 47% students are scoring more than 50% marks. Performance of students crossed the benchmark of 50% in class 5<sup>th</sup>. **In Mathematics**, performance of students is good in all classes i.e. more than 50% students are scoring above 50% marks; however, in class 4<sup>th</sup>, it has just crossed the minimum decided performance line. **In EVS**, performance of students is good as more than 50% students are achieving more than 50% marks in all three classes. Across upper primary classes, in January MAT 2018, **in Hindi**, performance of students is good in all three classes 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>; however, it is improved from class 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>. In English also, students are performing poorly in class 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> and in class 7<sup>th</sup>, it has just crossed the minimum decided performance line. **In Mathematics**, performance of students is poor in all three classes. **In Social Studies**, performance of students is poor in all three classes; however in class 6<sup>th</sup>, it is at 52% i.e. only 52% students are scoring more than 50% marks. In Science, students are performing well in all three classes.
